#### Two card trick

Stirling has launched a new preset card for the Lexicon PCM80 effects processor, effectively transforming it from a single stereo unit into a dual stereo unit. As well as 'doubling' the PCM80's capabilities, the PCM80 Dual FX card allows each stereo output to be individually balanced. The card also has a further 250 presets giving the unit nearly 500 separate presets in all. The card will sell for approximately £160 excluding VAT.

Stirling Audio also has the new Lexicon Nuverb TDM interface card, which allows the Niverb card to operate on a TDM bus. For the first time, the card gives the Lexicon Nuverb direct software access to Digidesign's Pro Tools hard disk recorder for the Apple Mac and many popular sequencing packages like Emagic's Logic Audio, and Cubase Audio. TDM interface card costs £319 excluding VAT.

### Positive feedback control


